

### Who we are

Mayberry Memorial exists to raise awareness of Lynch syndrome, which is a genetic condition that puts the carrier at a higher risk of certain types of aggressive cancer at a younger age.

We are fighting for Lynch syndrome Previvors to learn about their condition *before* they develop cancer.

## 2021 Accomplishments



### Fundraising

Raised \$17.2k in cash donations, plus an additional \$11.2k of in-kind donations – over a 300% increase from 2020

### Activities

Held 3 Cooking with Chef Kyle fundraisers, rebranded with a new logo and website, launched Project Conquer

### Impact

Created 82 new posts for Lynch syndrome awareness on Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, and LinkedIn

Our new flagship program provides free genetic counseling and genetic testing to qualifying applicants who have a high likelihood of carrying Lynch syndrome.

Our mission is to identify these people with Lynch so they can take preventative measures to avoid the cancers that they are at a higher risk of developing.






## New Brand and Website
